Online Holiday Shopping Tips

Many of us like to avoid the crowds during the holiday season by shopping online and having our packages delivered directly to our doorstep. Here are some things to keep in mind when looking for the perfect gift online.

Make sure sites are secure - Having a secure Internet connection is essential, but so is making sure your shopping site has proper security measures. Check your browser address bar to ensure online retailers use https in their URL. If the site is missing the s at the end of http, it could be fraudulent and is not secure when submitting payments.

Paying online - Using a debit card tied directly to your bank account can put you at risk. It's best to pay online with a credit card or a pre-paid debit card to help reduce risk.

Keep a list and check it twice - Track your spending and check your accounts regularly for suspicious activity. You can also set up text alerts through online banking to get notified of activity on your account.

Online thieves count on people being generous during the holidays and giving back to their community. This makes charitable contributions a little tricky at times. Follow these three simple steps and end the holidays with a warm heart instead of an empty bank account.

Check out the charity - Don't let someone pressure you to donate in person. Visit charitywatch.org, or givewell.org to learn more about your local charities

That's not one of Santa's elves - We all get them, the dreaded spam call or phishing email. During the holiday season, scammers go into hyperdrive as people try to take advantage of your giving spirit. Don't respond to unsolicited emails or phone calls about donations.

Keep a lookout for fake websites - Cybercriminals often create fake websites that look legitimate and can be very convincing. When giving online, check the spelling in the name of the charity in the web address and look closely for other discrepancies that might indicate it's not a legitimate website.


